Your child is working on transitioning to another school year by practicing social emotional skills they have learned in the classroom.

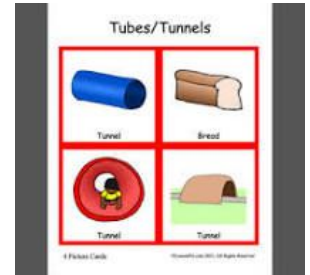
PreK children are getting ready for kindergarten! We'll have a kindergarten parent group on Friday 6/ 7 at 8.30 am. See you then!

What we will be learning about in the month of june : we will be continue learning and talking about kindergarten.

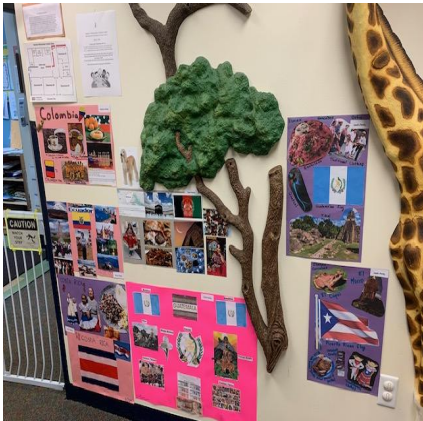
