The classrooms will be conducting Author Studies this month.


What is an Author study and why is it important?


- -Author studies give students the opportunity to compare and contrast books by the same author.

- -Boosts literacy skills




Our Authors this month are: Class 1 will be exploring Eric Carle Books!











Class 2 will be reading: Llama, Llama Books this month.

Second Step Updates: Classroom #1 has completed Unit 1: listening, focusing attention, using self-talk, and being assertive.

We are moving into Unit 2: Empathy Identifying feelings, happy, sad, surprised, scared, anger, same or different feelings for each person, accidents, caring and helping.

Baby Doll Updates: Classroom #2 Toddlers has been working on body parts self-awareness, secure relationships, expressing sympathy and empathy to others. We are moving into Boo Boo's Handling the hurts, recognizing and labeling emotions, expressing empathy to others, self-soothing and building trusting relationships. It was so sweet to see all the toddlers putting Band-Aids on and kissing their babies boo boos.



Friendship Groups: The groups are comprised of 5-6 children and last for 6 weeks. Our friendship group started its first group and the theme was how to make friends. Our other themes include:
