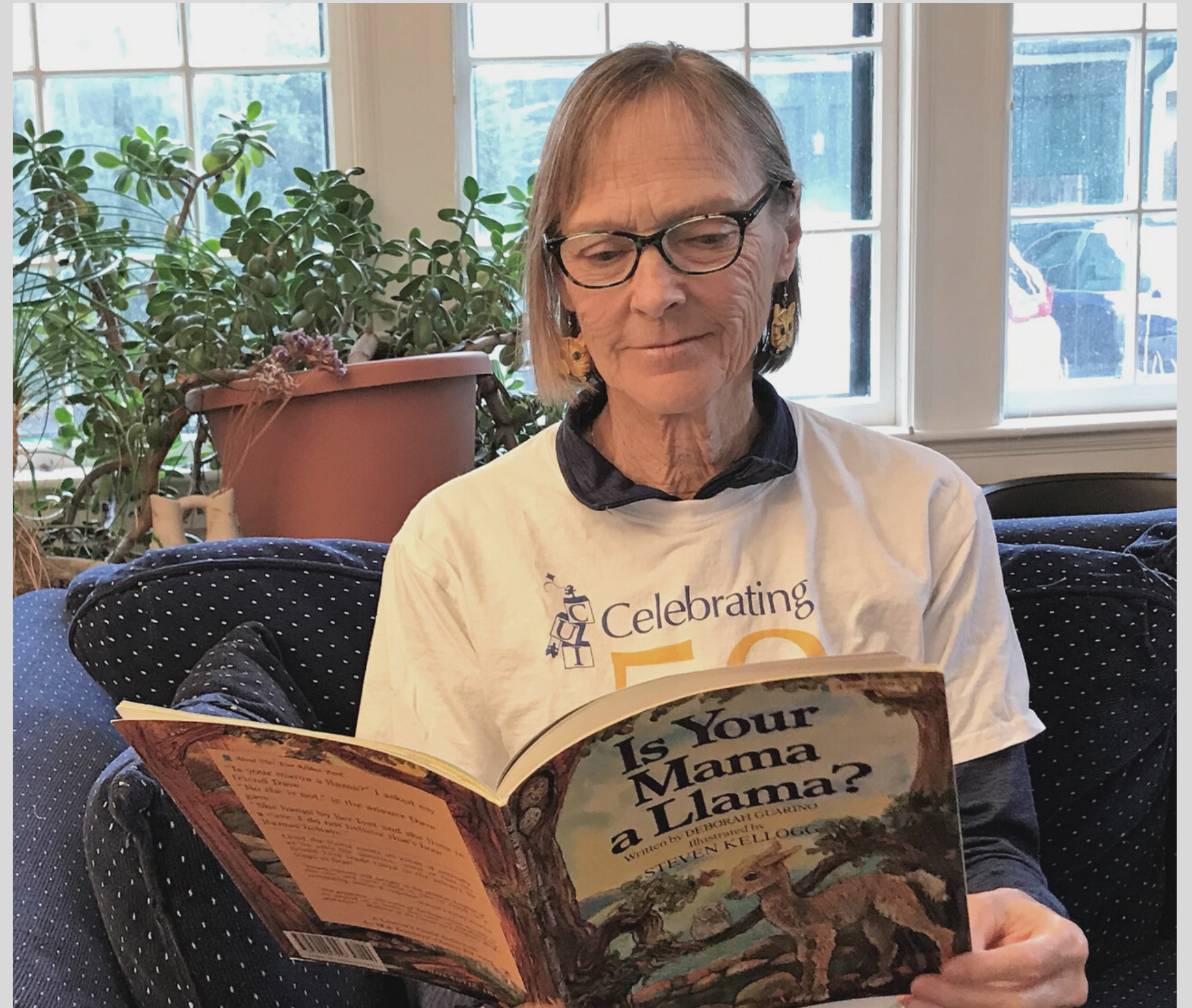


"Hi Ms. Fran,
